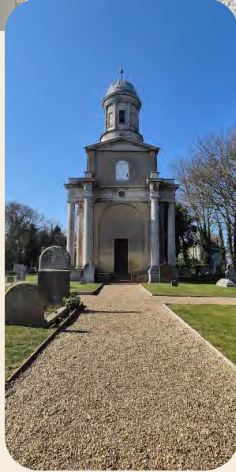


Mistley & Manningtree

10:00

Riverside Heritage

Start your day at Manningtree High Street and explore one of England's smallest towns, rich in Georgian architecture and independent shops.

Visit Manningtree Library & Museum for local archives and exhibitions. Walk to Mistley Towers and admire the neoclassical towers designed by Robert Adam in 1776. Located nearby, is the Swan Fountain which reflects Mistley's 18th-century spa town ambitions.

Heritage Trail Stop*

Visit the sculpted bench and information board near Mistley Quay. Use your phone to unlock augmented reality stories of those affected by the Essex witch trials.

This immersive experience honours lives impacted by persecution and folklore.

Follow woodland paths to Furze Hill to find Old Knobbley. A much loved 800 year old English Oak Tree with a trunk circumference of about 9.5m and just 4.3m in height.

Mistley to Manningtree Circular Walk is a gentle 5km loop through woodland, farmland, and estuary paths which includes Laundry Wood, Furze Hills, and scenic river views.
